Whether your goal is to acquire a literary agent or pitch your book directly to a royalty publisher, you will need a professional book proposal. Competition is fierce in the market today, and you want to present your work in the best possible light. Allison will read up to 50 typed pages of existing material (submitted at one time), including previous proposals, concept notes, chapter outline, and/or sample chapters. (Submissions must be typed and double-spaced.) Using an industry standard format, Allison will help you translate your concept into a detailed book proposal that will include pertinent author and target marketing information, as well as a synopsis, chapter outline, introduction, and sample chapter. She will advise you on content organization, approach, and style, including suggestions for research, identification of possible resources, and plans for writing.
