How it Works

Word Weavers meetings begin with prayer and a time of networking. Members share publishing accomplishments, writing news, and information about local writing events and conferences. The core focus of the meeting, however, is on critiques, which are limited to 1,500 words per member per meeting.

During critiques, members break up in small groups of six when peer writers read manuscripts aloud while others follow printed copies that you bring. After the piece is read, group members—some of whom are published authors—offer feedback on everything from plotting and character development to syntax and punctuation.
